Annual SSLA NROTC Leadership Awards:

This annual award recognizes five 1/C graduating female Midshipmen. Each NROTC Unit can nominate one top performer who has demonstrated superior leadership abilities through academic accomplishments, leadership style, commitment to core values, and community involvement.

Each award recipient will receive \$100 towards uniform purchases, a plaque from SSLA, one-year free membership to SSLA, and a one-time waiver of the registration fee to the annual Joint Women's Leadership Symposium.

Nominations are due 15 February each year for Midshipmen who will graduate in the Spring of that year. In order to best complete, please provide specific examples of achievements and any specific impact the Midshipman has made including metrics (hours volunteered, number of Midshipmen trained, etc).
